Description

Research activities leading to thesis, problem report, research paper or equivalent scholarly project, or a dissertation.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of six hours in this course, the student will:

- Prepare a research proposal and submit it to his/her graduate chair;
- Present the research proposal to his/her committee for approval;
- Conduct the research investigation necessary to collect required data;
- Analyze data according to specifications outlined in research proposal;
- Prepare written report (Chapters 4 & 5) on research findings;
- Successfully defend thesis research to his/her graduate committee; and
- Prepare an article or presentation for one of the following: *Journal of Agricultural Education*, National Agricultural Education Research Conference, North Central Agricultural Education Research Conference, or their equivalents in other professions.

Division of Credits

A maximum of six AGEE 697 credits may be earned during a Master's degree program. The credits will be divided and graded according to the following:

- 1 hour – Submit research proposal to student's advisor
- 2 hours – Graduate Committee approve research proposal
- 2 hours – Successfully defend thesis
