Pre-Student Teaching Requirements

In order to student teach you must:

Date Completed

1. Pass PPST (Pre Professional Skills Test)
 - Register via PRAXIS booklet
 - Should be taken sophomore or junior year
 - WVU must have scores prior to student teaching
 - Register for: **Reading** (10710)
 Writing (20720)
 Math (10730)

2. Pass Subject Assessment/Specialty Area Test
 - Specialty area is Agriculture
 - This is a 2-hour test. Scores must be received prior to student teaching
 - Tests areas of basic agriculture classes, FFA, SAEP
 - Register for: **Agriculture** (10700)

3. Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT)
 - Tests basic educational theories, classroom situations
 - Also knowledge of psychology, learning styles, teaching styles are helpful
 - Should be familiar with IEPs, LDs/BDs
 - Register for: **Grades 7-12** (30524)

4. Grade Point Average
 - Must have a 2.5 in order to student teach

5. Must apply for Student Teaching
 - Must get forms from C&I (Allen Hall) and submit them **One Year in Advance**
 - Must attend student teaching meetings
 - Must request AGEE student teacher placement

Applying for teacher certification is the responsibility of the student.
